ACTIVITIES IN CLASS

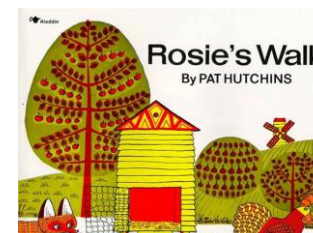
Self portraits
