Definition

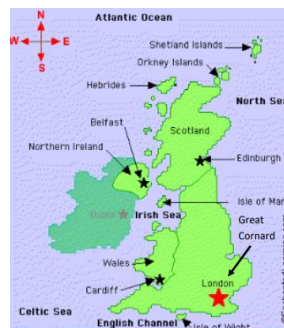
- City: A large town that usually has a cathedral.
- Country: A large area of land where people live under the same Government.
- British Isles: Great Britain, Ireland and all nearby islands.
- Continent: A group of countries on one large expanse of land.
- United Kingdom: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
- Coast: The land next to the ocean.
- Capital city: The main city in a country, usually where the Government is located.
- Compass: An instrument used to show North.
- Environment: A particular geographical area.

We will also be learning about the physical and human features of the seaside and the importance of keeping beaches clean.

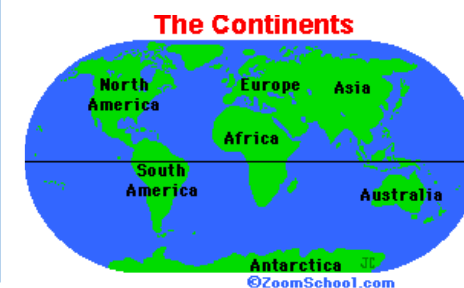
There are **seven continents** on Earth: Asia, Europe, Africa, North America, South America, Australia and Antarctica.
